On March 15, the 6<sup>th</sup> grade went to the Louisville Science Center. There, we saw an IMAX movie on the body, and went to a private pizza place.

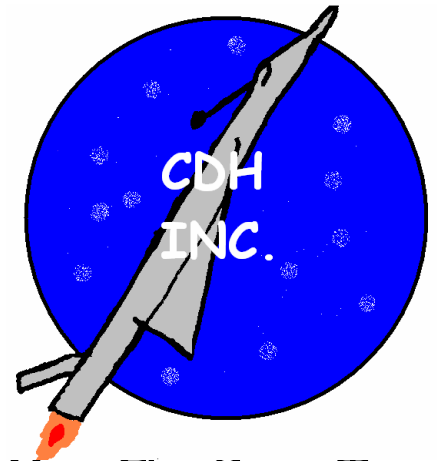
### In the Museum
